- Stretched vertically by 1.25x to adjust for the bead aspect ratio.
- Added side rows to space ghosts away from the clasps.
- Three length options: conventionally men's, women's, and kids' sizes.

Sizes *(Delica 11/0 or Aiko)*

Dimensions

13x97 rows (+2 rows inside clasps)

Width

1.85cm (fits into any **20mm** clasp tube: Miyuki, Finrusiac or generic Chinese tubes)

Length

- Beadwork length: **16.5cm**
- Length with clasp tubes: **17.3cm**
- Total length (incl. tubes & average lobster lock): **≈19cm**

Fits a **18cm** wrist and above.

Working thread estimation

Take **4.5 meters or more**, based on the following calculation:

$$(\text{1.85cm} \times \text{2} \times \text{99rows}) + (\text{0.25cm} \times \text{99rows}) = \text{390cm} \text{ (take 4.5m)}$$

Dimensions

13×84 rows (+2 rows inside clasps)

Width

1.85cm (fits into any **20mm** clasp tube: Miyuki, Finrusiac or generic Chinese tubes)

Length

- Beadwork length: **14.3cm**
- Length with clasp tubes: **15.1cm**
- Total length (incl. tubes & average lobster lock): **≈17cm**

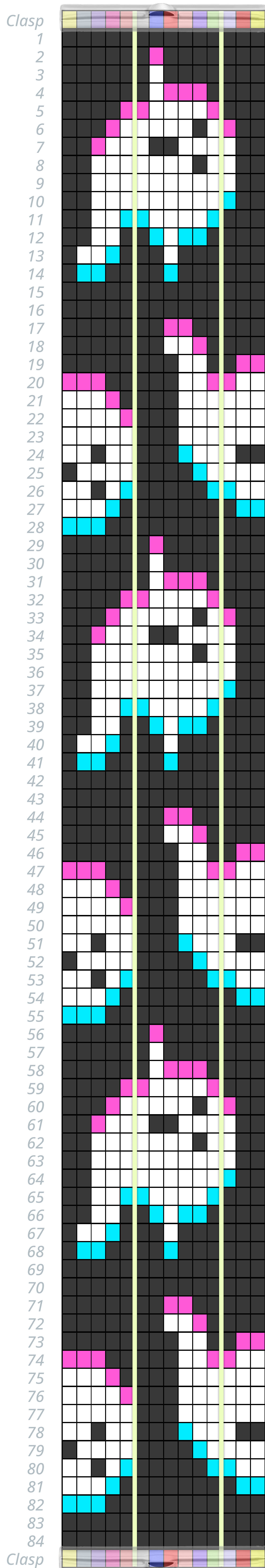
Fits a **16cm** wrist and above.

Working thread estimation

Take **4 meters or more**, based on the following calculation:

$$\left(\underset{\text{row width}}{1.85\text{cm}} \times \underset{\text{row passes}}{2 \times 86\text{rows}} \right) + \left(\underset{\text{thread turns}^*}{0.25\text{cm}} \times \underset{\text{row count}}{86\text{rows}} \right) = \underset{\text{net length}}{340\text{cm}} \text{ (take 4m)}$$

* The working thread loses about 0.15cm when transitioning to the next row, and another 0.1cm on the U-turn around the outermost warp thread.

Dimensions

13×70 rows (+2 rows inside clasps)

Width

1.85cm (fits into any **20mm** clasp tube: Miyuki, Finrusiac or generic Chinese tubes)

Length

- Beadwork length: **11.9cm**
- Length with clasp tubes: **12.7cm**
- Total length (incl. tubes & average lobster lock): **≈14.5cm**

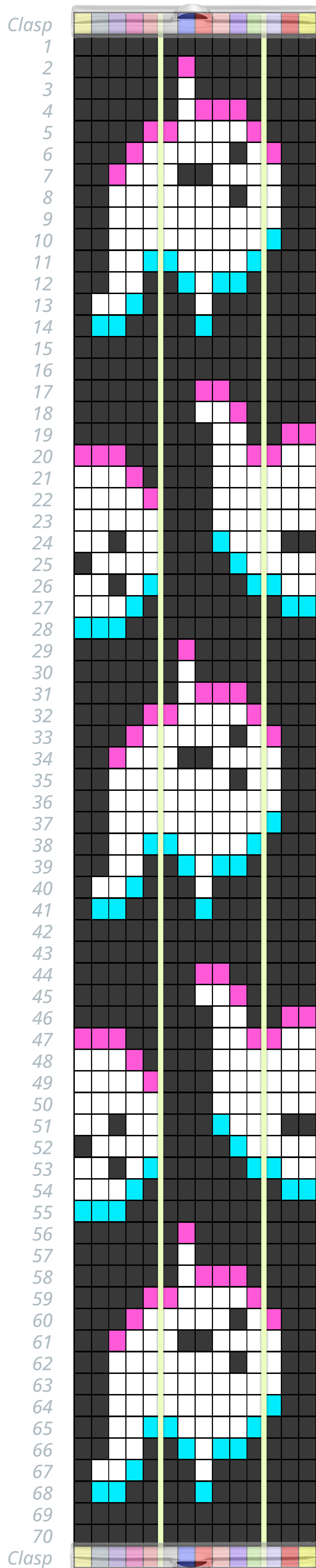
Fits a **13.5cm** wrist and above.

Working thread estimation

Take **3.5 meters or more**, based on the following calculation:

$$\left(\underset{\text{row width}}{1.85\text{cm}} \times \underset{\text{row passes}}{2 \times 72\text{rows}} \right) + \left(\underset{\text{thread turns}^*}{0.25\text{cm}} \times \underset{\text{row count}}{72\text{rows}} \right) = \underset{\text{net length}}{284\text{cm}} \text{ (take 3.5m)}$$

* The working thread loses about 0.15cm when transitioning to the next row, and another 0.1cm on the U-turn around the outermost warp thread.



Colors

Even though this was one of the earliest bracelets and the bead selection was very limited back then, my wife managed to nail great colors on the very first try. We still use them to this day whenever we remake this bracelet. Except now we're leaning more toward a matte background instead of the usual non-extra finish, but both options look great nevertheless!

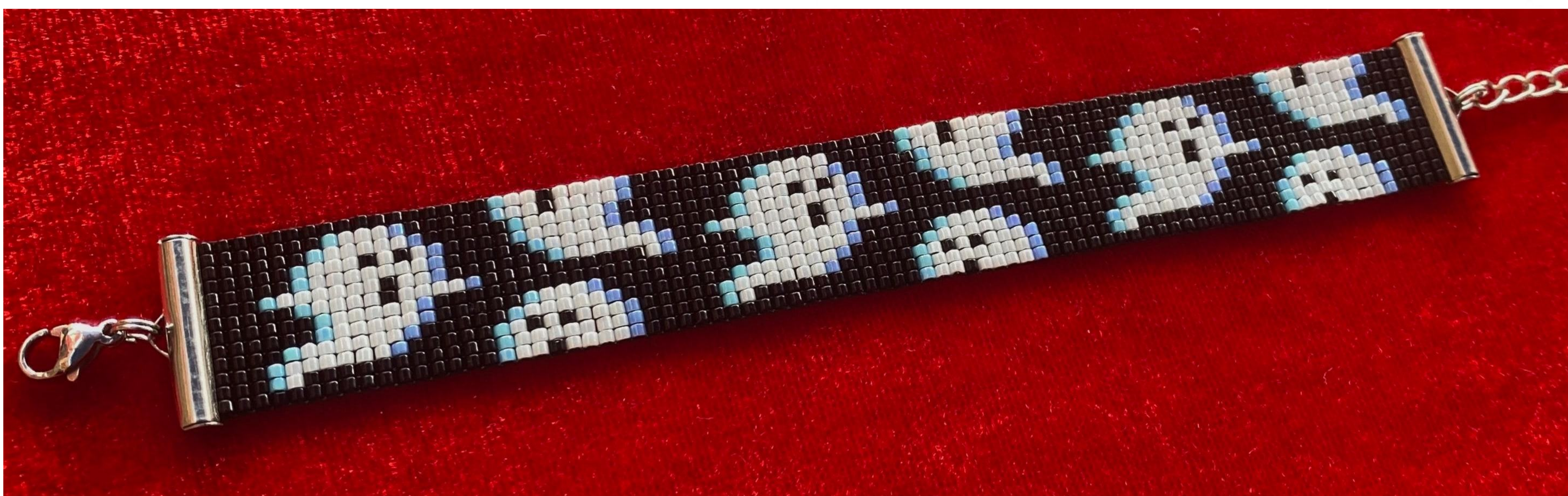
